I further agree, at my own cost and expense, to defend any claim, suit, action or proceeding which may be commenced against myself or any of my agents, servants, representatives or persons action on my behalf and/or against the City or Library; and I agree to pay any and all judgments or settlements which may be recovered in any suit, action or proceeding and any and all expenses, including, but not limited to, costs, attorney fees and settlement expenses which may be incurred by reason of such claim, suit, action or proceeding.

## Application process:

1. Submit application to the Youth Services Desk **before the training session** you plan to attend, and **no later than June 6**. Interested applicants must attend a training session, however, **spaces are limited, and applying to volunteer does not guarantee placement**. The sooner we receive your application, the better your chances of receiving desired hours and times.
2. **Choose ONE of the mandatory training sessions to attend:**

Monday June 4, 7:15-8:30pm  
Wednesday June 6, 7:15-8:30pm
3. **Come to the Youth Activity Room on your chosen date!**
4. **Positions confirmed and schedules finalized** after Training Session is completed.
