Faust Public Library of Westland, the Library Board and its elected and appointed officials, employees, agents, servants and others working on behalf of the City or Library from any and all actions, causes of action, liability, claims, demands, damages, costs, loss of services, expenses, compensation, attorney fees and litigation expenses and all consequential damages that I may have against the City, the Library and its employees, agents, officials or servants on account of, or in any way growing out of or caused by any and all activities _____ has engaged in or may engage in as a volunteer on behalf of the Library, including any and all known and unknown personal injuries, death and property damage that may result, including, but not limited to, any and all personal injuries or property damage which in any way results from or is in any way related to participation as a volunteer on behalf of the Library; and, I also agree that to the fullest extent permitted by law that I will indemnify and hold harmless the City of Westland, the Library Board and its elected and appointed officials, employees, agents, servants and others working on behalf of the City or Library from and against any and all injury, loss, cost, expense, damage, liability or claims, whether groundless or not, which are caused by or are as a result of the intentional or negligent actions of _____ as a volunteer on behalf of the Library or any of my agents, servants, representatives or persons acting on my behalf. I further agree, at my own cost and expense, to defend any claim, suit, action or proceeding which may be commenced against myself or any of my agents, servants, representatives or persons action on my behalf and/or against the City or Library; and I agree to pay any and all judgments or settlements which may be recovered in any suit, action or proceeding and any and all expenses, including, but not limited to, costs, attorney fees and settlement expenses which may be incurred by reason of such claim, suit, action or proceeding.

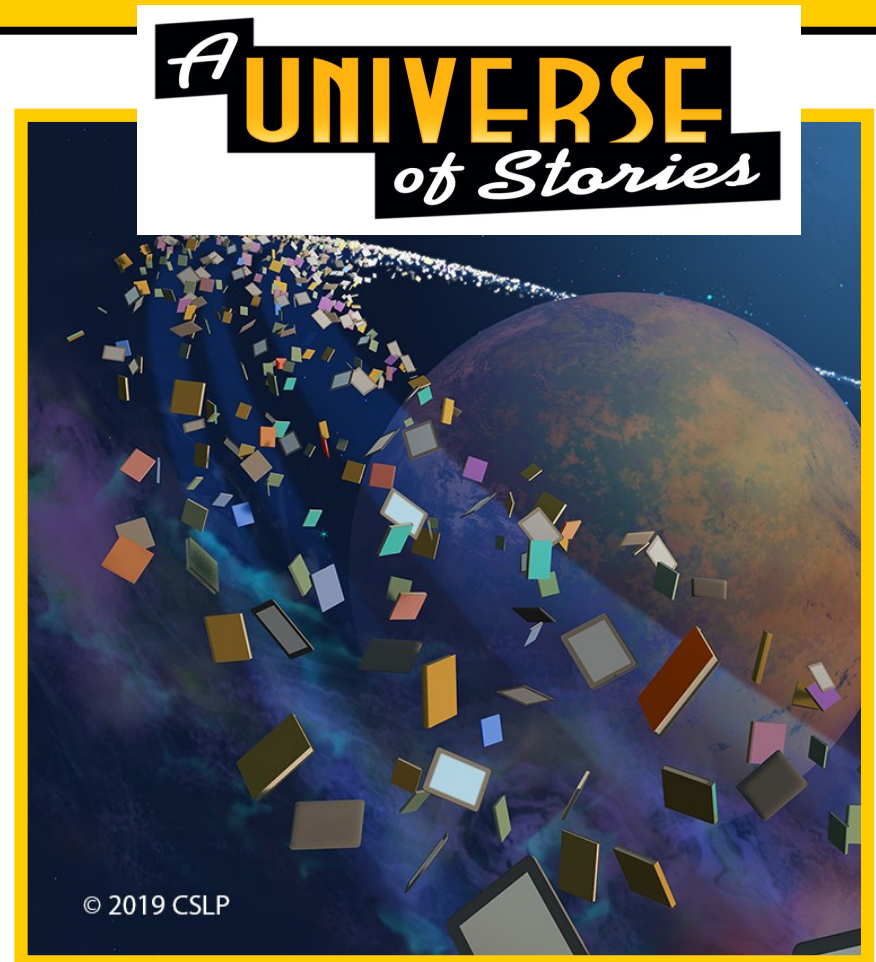
