

WIRELESS HOTSPOTS

Instructions for Use

A strong cellular signal is needed; if you are in a location where you do not get cell phone service, the wireless hotspot will not work either.

Average 4G LTE download speeds are between 6 – 8 Megabits per second (Mbps), but performance varies higher and lower depending on a variety of factors. There is no cap on total bandwidth use.

Basic instructions:

1. Turn on the hotspot and wait for it to establish a connection.
2. If it does not turn on, it may require charging the hotspot with the enclosed charger. A charge usually lasts approximately 3 hours of constant use.
3. On your WiFi enabled device, locate the WiFi network, connect to it, and supply the password. The WiFi network name and password are on the instruction card inside the hotspot case.

CAUTION: Please avoid overcharging the hotspot, which may result in overheating. Unplug the hotspot after charging to avoid overheating. Do not leave it in a car.

NOTE: the hotspot may become warm while charging, which is not a malfunction. However, stop using it immediately if it becomes extremely hot.
